## Description

Hard, coarse, brown clay; lightly burnished dark gray slip; lighter line at middle of body. Hemispherical with rounded bottom; triangular wishbone handle below rim. Decoration in matte brownish-black paint: frieze of hooked chains framed by horizontal ladder pattern interrupted at the handle and front; frontal decoration, pair of vertical hatched ladders with pendant ladder between; two pendant rows of dots within; horizontal lines across halfway down; pendant from frieze on each size, a hatched ladder flanked by two pendant ladders; below handle, pair of vertical hatched ladders with pendant ladder between; horizontal line across; on top of handle, four ladder patterns without cross strokes; circles around handle bases; line along both shanks of handle underneath. Slight crack in vessel wall.
